

# Standardised Price List 1867

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (*because prices can vary*).

## Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£575.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death ( <i>normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's Premises</i> ) into the Funeral Director's care	£260.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities The deceased person will rest at both the funeral director's head office or branch office	£565.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from wood veneer with a teak stain	£275.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director. ( <i>Where viewing is requested by the customer</i> )	£440.00
At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium ( <i>normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Director's premises</i> ) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£300.00

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or

Burial ( <i>Funeral Director's charges only</i> )	£2670.00
Cremation ( <i>Funeral Director's charges plus the cremation fee</i> ) <sup>2</sup>	£1699.00

## Fees you must pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee <sup>1</sup>	£450 - £ 1565
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: ( <i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees</i> )	£396 - £ 1565
For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee	Southend £1100 Basildon £1245 - £1345

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
